Scripture at Monaro High has been going through some up and down periods over the last few weeks. This is due to both my own personal situation over the last few weeks and on going confusion for the students regarding timetabling and communication.

This term I have introduced the new curriculum to the students and although it is structured differently to my previous lessons they have seemed to accept the change smoothly. I personally have found the curriculum well put together and its layout is easy to follow. I feel that some of the concepts are not explained the best but with some slight changes in illustrations this is easily overcome.

Year 7
