With Mr Andy Winfield back in the Deputy Principals office I was hoping for some much needed consistency with scripture after having a variety of relieving deputy's in the role. With the start of Term 3 I was happy to see that the timetabling of SRE at Monaro was being sorted early in the term rather than later and I was able to have my first class in the second week of term.

This Term the units that the students are doing are "Paul in Acts" for year 7 and "Peter in Acts" for year 8.

Paul in Acts looks at the journey in faith that Paul had while also looking at his ministry trips that he took and the impact that had on the spread of the gospel to the non-Jewish people.

Peter in Acts looks at the journey of Faith that Peter took from his time with Jesus to being the head of the church in the 1st century and how he affected the spread of the gospel amongst the Jewish people.

With a few issues cleared up from last semester I have about 30 students in each year. Which makes for a good size class when teaching.
